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Patient Encounters

GENERAL FINDINGS

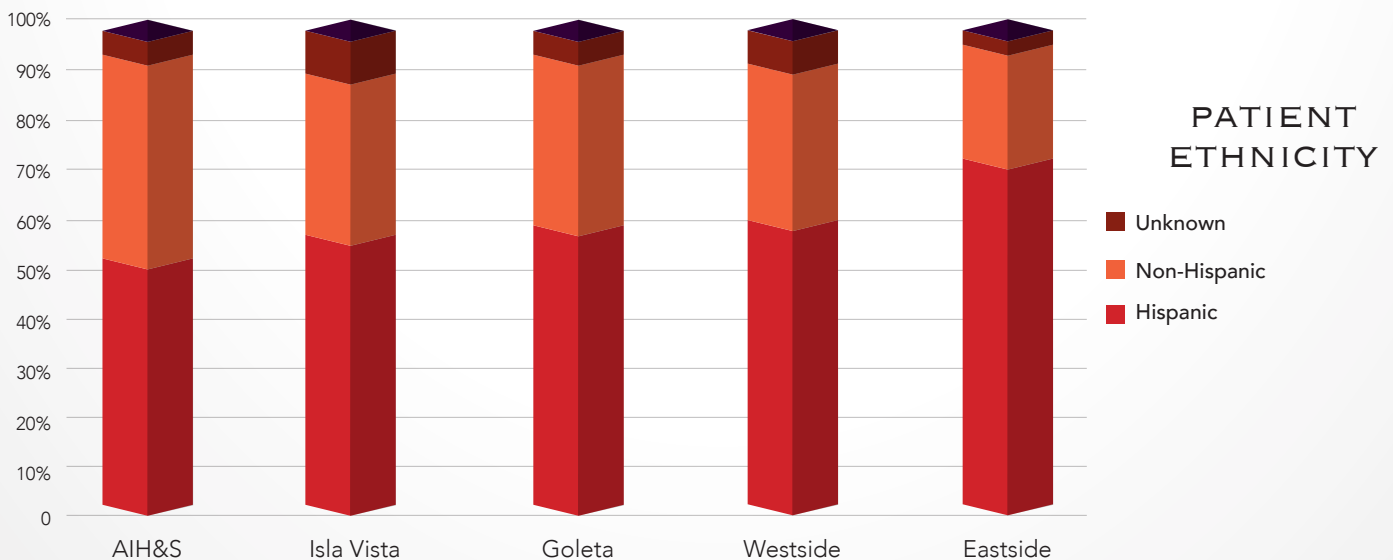
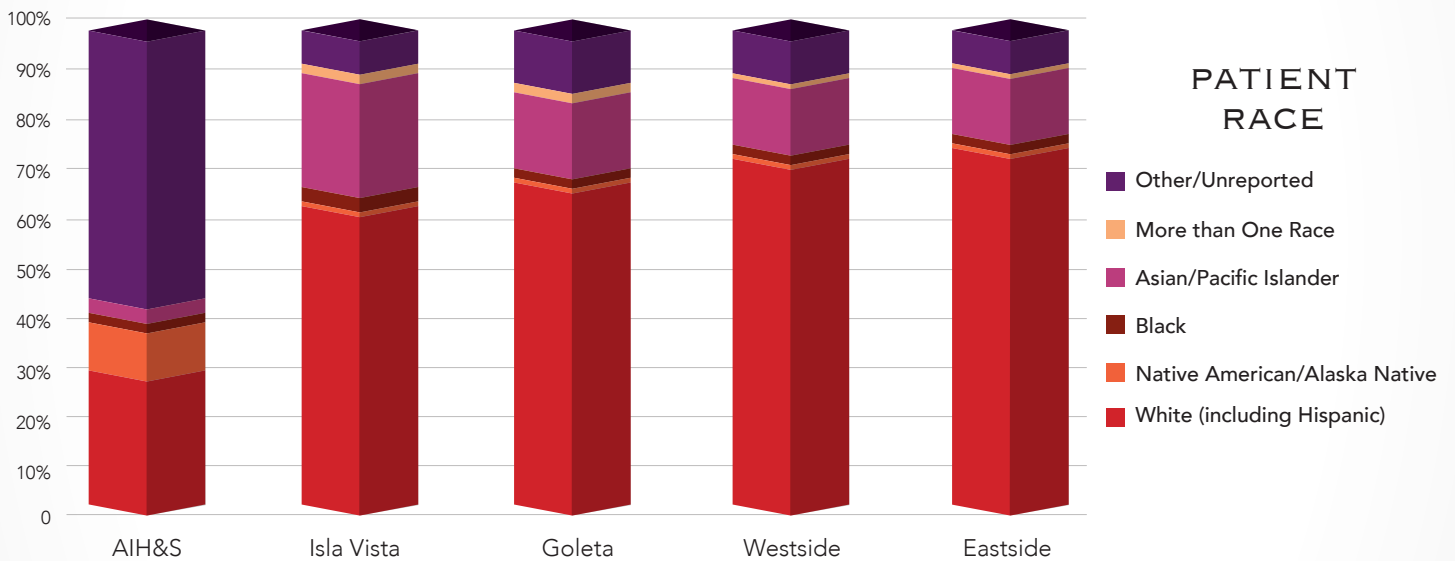
In 2017, American Indian Health & Services (AIHS) had 4.8 encounters per patient on average. AIHS and Eastside Neighborhood Clinic had 31,332 and 25,822 patient encounters respectively, representing the two clinics with the greatest number of encounters. This difference is partially explained by the presence of dental services in both of these clinics, while the other three Santa Barbara Neighborhood Clinics (SBNCs) do not provide these services. Though both AIHS and Eastside offer dental services, and acknowledging Eastside serves over 1,200 more patients than AIHS, AIHS had over 5,000 more encounters than Eastside Neighborhood Clinic in 2017.



Patient Race and Ethnicity

GENERAL FINDINGS

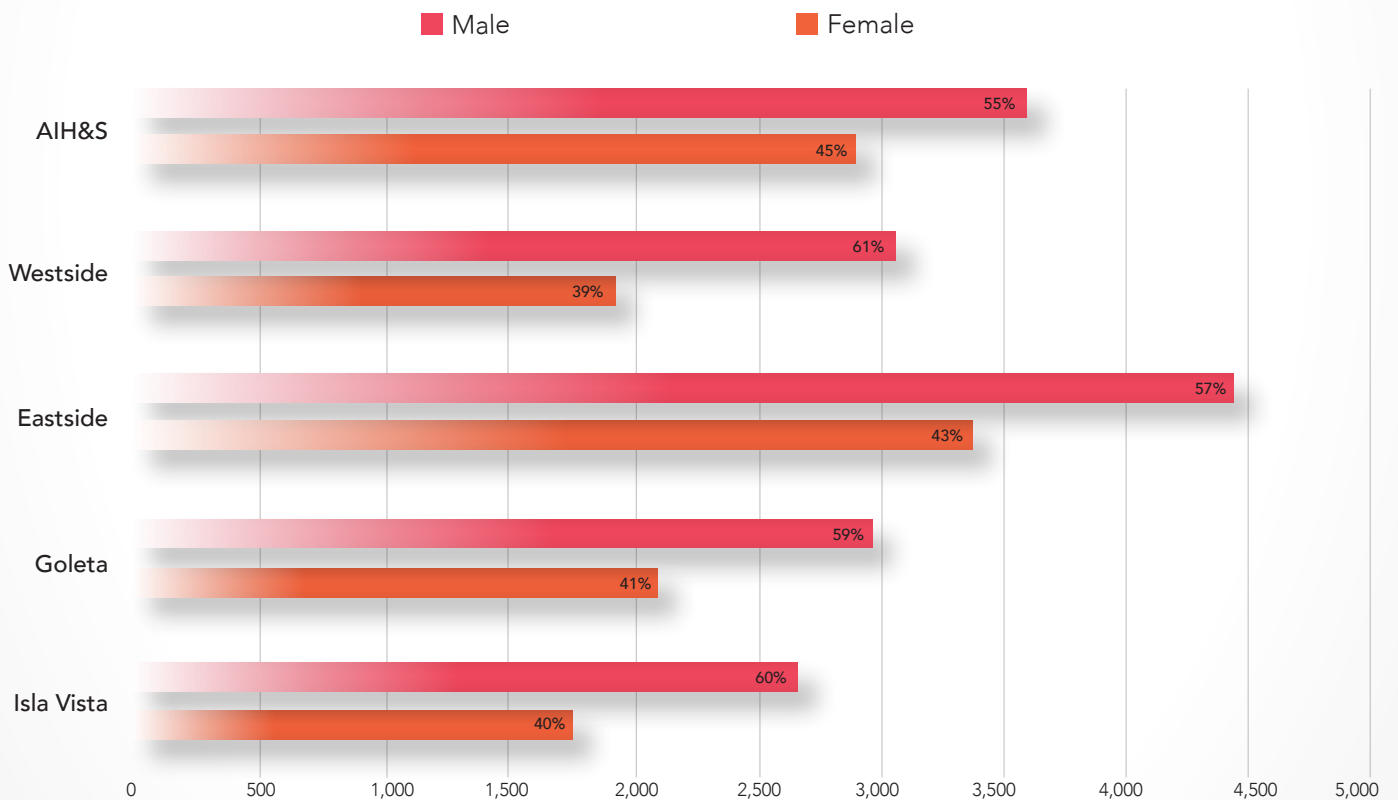
AIHS reported the highest Native American/Alaskan Native population of the five health centers evaluated. Over 50% of the AIHS patient population were reported as Other/Unknown. This was nearly five times greater than any of the SBNCs. Additionally, AIHS had the largest population of patients who were reported with Unknown ethnicity.



Patient Gender

GENERAL FINDINGS

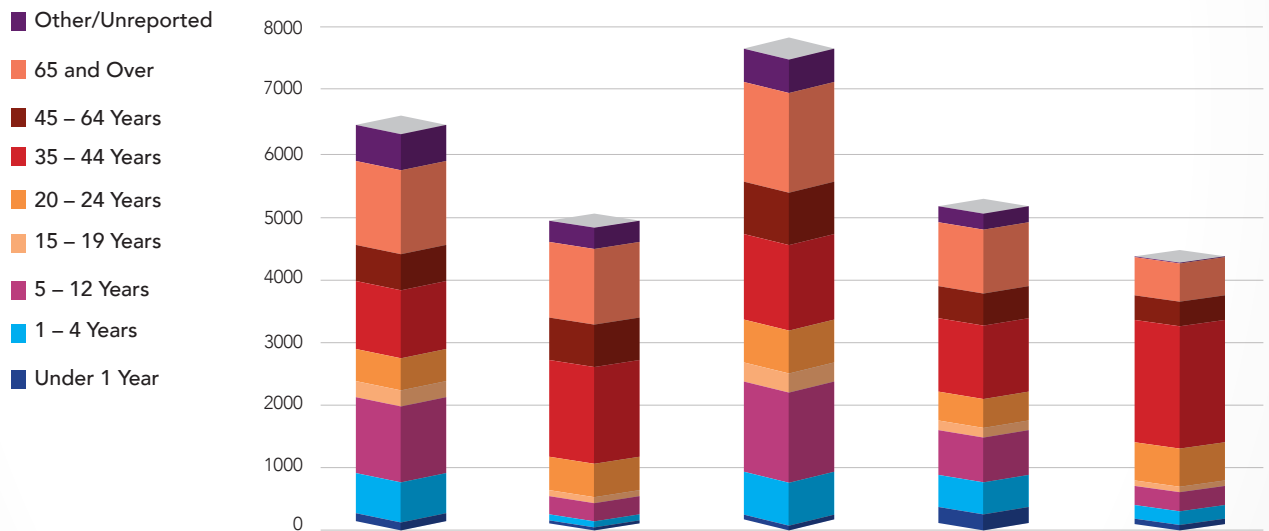
In each of the five health centers female patients made up more than half of the population, representing from 55% to 61% of the health center registrants. With 45% of the patient population male, AIHS has the with the largest percentage of male patients compared to the SBNCs. Eastside Neighborhood clinic also has a large male population. This difference from the other SBNCs may be due to the presence of dental clinics at these two sites.



Patient Age Distribution

GENERAL FINDINGS

The reported age distribution is relatively constant across each of the health centers evaluated. Goleta, Eastside, and AIHS see significantly more pediatric patients than the Westside and Isla Vista Neighborhood clinics. AIHS has the second largest population of children under the age of 5, with 805 individuals and 12% of their patient population represented by this group. Isla Vista Neighborhood clinic has the largest population of individuals age 20-34 years.

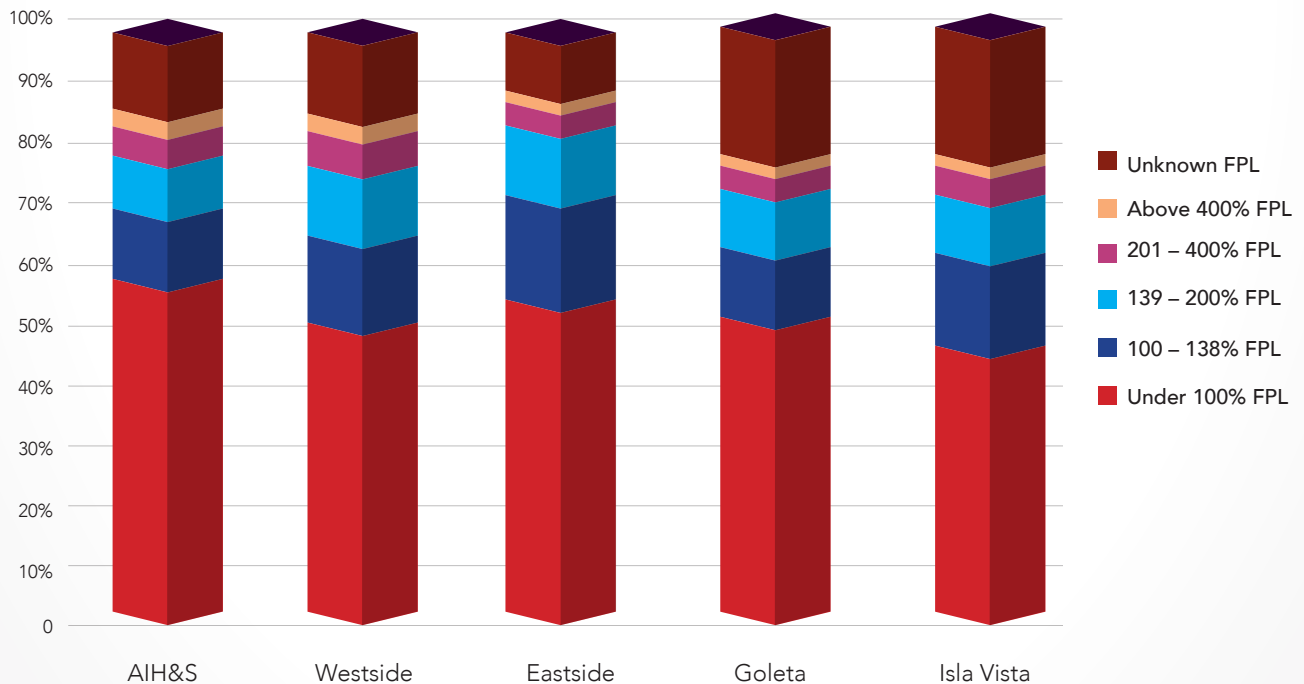

Patient Relationship to FPL

GENERAL FINDINGS

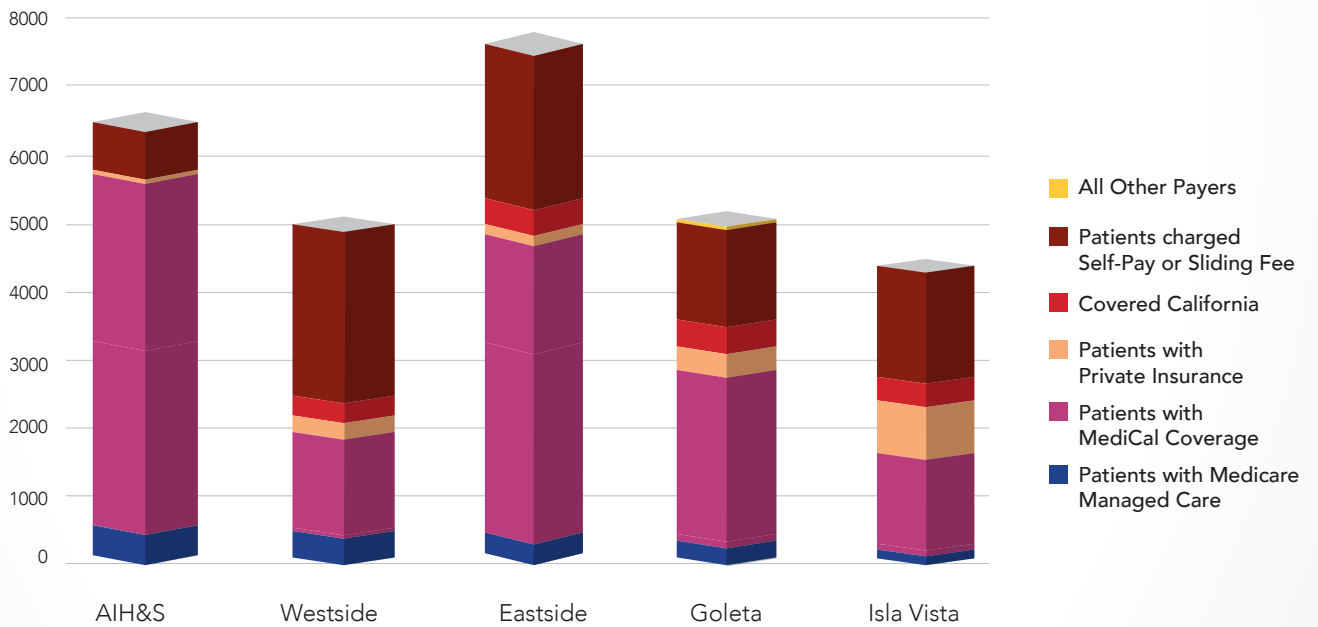
In each of the community health centers represented, patient relationship to the FPL was consistent. For all clinics, the majority of patients are under 138% FPL. Additionally, in all clinics, less than 10% of the patient population was above 200% FPL. All clinics also had many patients whose relationship to the FPL was unknown. With 22% unknown, AIHS and Westside Neighborhood Clinic had nearly twice as high a percent of patients with an unknown FPL relationship compared to the other 3 SBNCs.



Patient Coverage

GENERAL FINDINGS

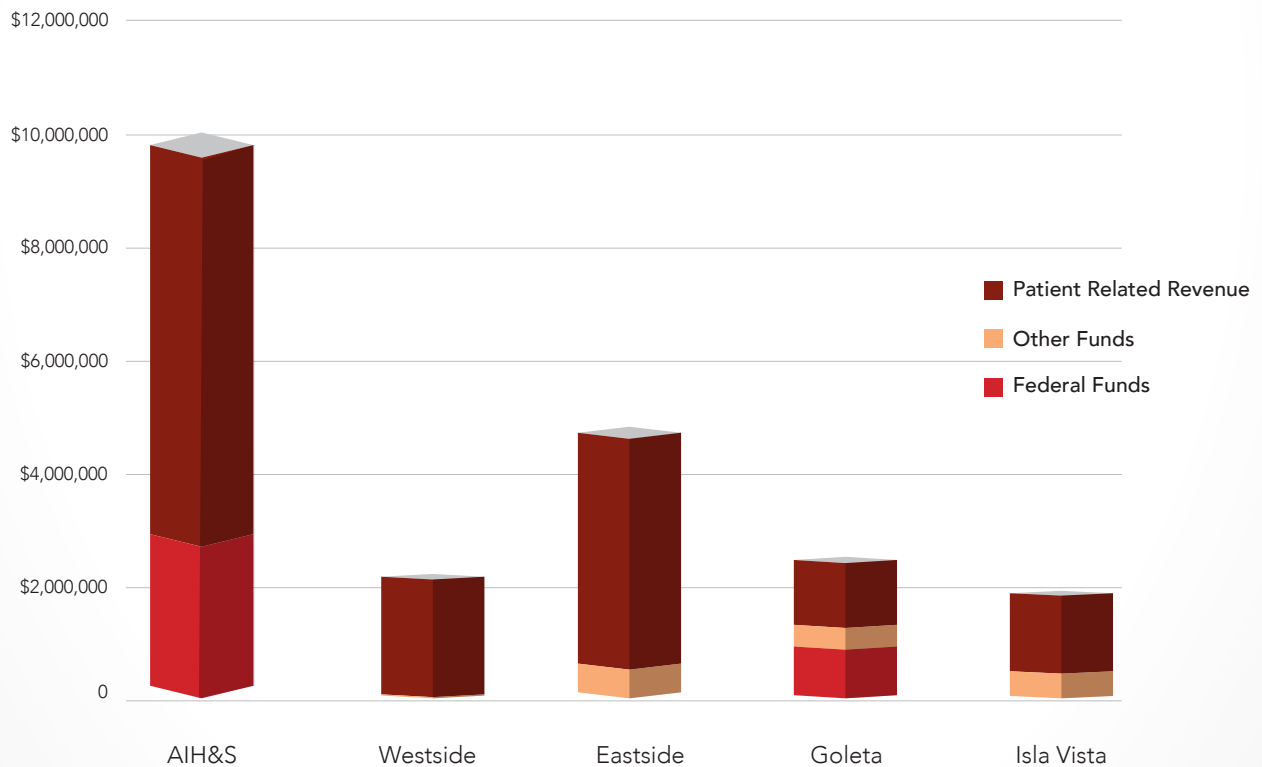
Of the five health centers, AIHS had the largest population of patients who were covered through Medi-Cal and Medicare. AIHS also had the smallest population of patients who were charged via Self-Pay/Sliding Fees. The other four health centers each had patients who have coverage through Covered California. AIHS did not have a reported population for this category. AIHS had the smallest number of patients who had private insurance (47 patients).



Revenue Source

GENERAL FINDINGS

Of all health centers evaluated, AIHS reported the highest Patient Related Revenue and Federal funding. Other Funds, including private funding and donations, made up a small percentage of revenue in AIHS and Westside, .26% and 1.1% respectively, while at the SBNC locations: Isla Vista, Goleta, and Eastside, these represented significant sources of revenue. None of the health centers evaluated reported any State, County, or Local funding.
